CROSS 1

Luke 14 27 says

And whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple.

Matthew 16 24 says

Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wants to be my disciple

must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me.

Matthew 10 38 and 39 say

Whoever does not take up their cross and follow me is not worthy of me.

Whoever finds their life will lose it, and whoever loses their life for my sake will find it.

Matthew 16 26 says

What good will it be for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul?

Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul?

Mark 10 21 says

Jesus looked at him and loved him. "One thing you lack," he said. "Go, sell everything you have

and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."

Luke 9 23 and 24 say

Then he said to them all: "Whoever wants to be my disciple

must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me.

For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will save it.

John 3 14 to 16 we read

Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness,

so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes may have eternal life in him."

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son,

that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Acts 5 30 and 31 say

The God of our ancestors raised Jesus from the dead, whom you killed by hanging him on a cross.

God exalted him to his own right hand as Prince and Savior that he might bring Israel to repentance and forgive their sins.

Romans 5 6 says

You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly.

Romans 5 8 says

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

First Corinthians 1 17 and 18 say

For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel,

not with wisdom and eloquence, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.

For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

First Corinthians 15 3 to 5 we read

For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance :

that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, and then to the Twelve.

Yes ! God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

So, let us deny ourselves and take up our cross daily and follow Jesus and become His disciples.
