DELIVERANCE 1

Psalms 50 15 says

and call on me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me."

Isaiah 31 5 says

Isaiah 19 20 says

Isaiah 58 6 and 7 say

Psalms 72 12 says
