FRUITFULNESS 1

John 15 8 says

This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

Psalms 1 1,2 and 3 say

Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers,

but whose delight is in the law of the LORD, and who meditates on his law day and night.

That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither, whatever they do prospers.

John 15 16 says

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit, fruit that will last, and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you.

Galatians 5 22 and 23 say

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Matthew 3 8 says

Produce fruit in keeping with repentance.

John 15 4 and 5 say

Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

Proverbs 18 21 says

The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

James 3 17 and 18 say

But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere.

Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness.

Leviticus 26 3 and 4 say

'If you follow my decrees and are careful to obey my commands,

I will send you rain in its season, and the ground will yield its crops and the trees their fruit.

Ephesians 5 11 says

Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them.

Matthew 13:23 says

But the seed falling on good soil refers to someone who hears the word and understands it. This is the one who produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown."

Luke 6 43 and 44 say

"No good tree bears bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit.

Each tree is recognized by its own fruit. People do not pick figs from thornbushes, or grapes from briars.

Proverbs 11 30 says

The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and the one who is wise saves lives.

Yes ! When we delight in the law of the LORD, and meditate on his law day and night, whatever we do would prosper.

Let us give fruit of the Spirit and produce fruit, in keeping with repentance by which Father will be glorified.
