RESURRECTED POWER OF JESUS CHRIST MINISTRY







James 4 10 says

Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.

Romans 12 16 says

Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.

Second Corinthians 12 9 and 10 say

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."

Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.

That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties.

For when I am weak, then I am strong.

Ephesians 4 2 and 3 say

Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.

Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

Philippians 2 3 to 8 we read

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves,

not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:

Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;

rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death, even death on a cross!

Colossians 3 12 and 13 say

Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved,

clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.

Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

Colossians 2:18 says

Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you.

Such a person also goes into great detail about what they have seen; they are puffed up with idle notions by their unspiritual mind.

Colossians 2 23 says

Such regulations indeed have an appearance of wisdom, with their self-imposed worship,

their false humility and their harsh treatment of the body, but they lack any value in restraining sensual indulgence.

James 4 6 says

But he gives us more grace. That is why Scripture says: "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble."

James 4 14 to 16 we read

Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life?

You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes.

Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that."

As it is, you boast in your arrogant schemes. All such boasting is evil.

First Peter 5 5 says

In the same way, you who are younger, submit yourselves to your elders.

All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble."

Let us clothe ourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.
