OUR BODY IS A TEMPLE

First Corinthians 3 17 says

God's temple is sacred, and you together are that temple.

First Corinthians 6 19 and 20 say

Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit,

who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own;

you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.

First Corinthians 3 16 and 17 say

Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your midst?

If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person;

for God's temple is sacred, and you together are that temple.

Romans 12 1 and 2 say

Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy,

to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God, this is your true and proper worship.

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.

Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is, his good, pleasing and perfect will.

Matthew 6 22 and 23 say

"The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are healthy, your whole body will be full of light.

But if your eyes are unhealthy, your whole body will be full of darkness.

If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness!

Second Corinthians 6 14 to 16 we read

Do not be yoked together with unbelievers.

For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness?

What harmony is there between Christ and Belial ? Or what does a believer have in common with an unbeliever?

What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God.

As God has said: "I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people."

First Corinthians 12 27 says
Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it.

First Corinthians 6 13 says
You say, "Food for the stomach and the stomach for food, and God will destroy them both.

The body, however, is not meant for sexual immorality but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body.

First Timothy 4 8 says
For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come.

Romans 8 10 says
But if Christ is in you, then even though your body is subject to death because of sin,
the Spirit gives life because of righteousness.

Second Corinthians 4 6 and 7 say
For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," made his light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory displayed in the face of Christ.

But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us.

Galatians 2 20 says
I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me.

The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Ephesians 3 17 says
so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love,

First Corinthians 10 31 says

So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

Philippians 1 20 says

I eagerly expect and hope that I will in no way be ashamed, but will have sufficient courage

so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death.
