PROCLAIM THE GOSPEL

Mark 16 15 says

He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

First Corinthians 9 16 says

For when I preach the gospel, I cannot boast, since I am compelled to preach. Woe to me if I do not preach the gospel!

Second Timothy 4 2 says

Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage, with great patience and careful instruction.

Matthew 24 14 says

And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

Psalms 105 1 says

Give praise to the LORD, proclaim his name; make known among the nations what he has done.

Matthew 4 17 says

From that time on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

Luke 4 43 says

But he said, "I must proclaim the good news of the kingdom of God to the other towns also, because that is why I was sent."

Matthew 4 23 says

Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom,

and healing every disease and sickness among the people.

Second Timothy 2 15 says

Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved,

a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.

Second Timothy 4 5 says

But you, keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry.

Romans 1 16 says

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.

Romans 1 17 says

For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed —a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written:

"The righteous will live by faith."

Isaiah 52 7 says

How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace,

who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!"

First Peter 2 9 says

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession,

that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

Acts 5 42 says

Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house,

they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Messiah.

Acts 10 42 says

He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one whom God appointed as judge of the living and the dead.

Colossians 1 23 says

if so be that ye continue in the faith, grounded and stedfast, and not moved away from the hope of the gospel which ye heard,

which was preached in all creation under heaven; whereof I Paul was made a minister.

First Thessalonians 1 5 says

because our gospel came to you not simply with words but also with power, with the Holy Spirit and deep conviction.

You know how we lived among you for your sake.

First Peter 3 15 says

But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you

to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect,

Matthew 28 19 and 20 say

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Yes ! Coming of Jesus Christ is very soon. It is a compulsion to preach the Gospel.

Jesus Christ died for us. Rose from the dead. He is coming back to take us to Heaven. Let us proclaim this message to the world.
