REPENTANCE

Matthew 4 17 says

From that time on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

Second Chronicles 7 14 says

if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways,

then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

First John 1 9 says

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

Acts 3 20 says

and that he may send the Messiah, who has been appointed for you, even Jesus.

Proverbs 28 13 says

Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy.

Matthew 3 8 says

Produce fruit in keeping with repentance.

Second Chronicles 30 9 says

If you return to the LORD, then your fellow Israelites and your children will be shown compassion by their captors and will return to this land,

for the LORD your God is gracious and compassionate. He will not turn his face from you if you return to him."

Second Peter 3 9 says

The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness.

Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

Matthew 9 13 says

But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice.' For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners."

James 4 8 says

Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

Revelation 3 19 says

Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest and repent.

Joel 2 13 says

Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the LORD your God,

for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and he relents from sending calamity.

Luke 15 7 says

I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

Ezekiel 18 32 says

For I take no pleasure in the death of anyone, declares the Sovereign LORD. Repent and live!

Acts 17 30 says

In the past God overlooked such ignorance, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent.

Mark 1 15 says

The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!"

Zechariah 1 3 says

Therefore tell the people: This is what the LORD Almighty says:

'Return to me,' declares the LORD Almighty, 'and I will return to you,' says the LORD Almighty.

Luke 15 10 says

In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

Luke 13 3 says

I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish.

Acts 2 38 says

Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins.

And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Proverbs 1 23 says

Repent at my rebuke! Then I will pour out my thoughts to you, I will make known to you my teachings.

Proverbs 1 30 says

Since they would not accept my advice and spurned my rebuke,

Luke 17 3 and 4 say

So watch yourselves. "If your brother or sister sins against you, rebuke them; and if they repent, forgive them.

Even if they sin against you seven times in a day and seven times come back to you saying 'I repent,' you must forgive them."
