SONSHIP 1

Romans 8 14 says

For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God.

Second Samuel 7 14 says

I will be his father, and he will be my son.

When he does wrong, I will punish him with a rod wielded by men, with floggings inflicted by human hands.

First Chronicles 17 12 to 14 we read

He is the one who will build a house for me, and I will establish his throne forever.

I will be his father, and he will be my son. I will never take my love away from him, as I took it away from your predecessor.

I will set him over my house and my kingdom forever; his throne will be established forever."

First Chronicles 28 6 says

He said to me: 'Solomon your son is the one who will build my house and my courts, for I have chosen him to be my son, and I will be his father.

Matthew 5 9 says

Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.

Luke 6 35 says

But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back.

Then your reward will be great, and you will be children of the Most High, because he is kind to the ungrateful and wicked.

John 1 12 and 13 say

Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God

children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God

John 8 35 and 36 say

Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever.

So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

Romans 1 5 says

Through him we received grace and apostleship to call all the Gentiles to the obedience that comes from faith for his name's sake.

Romans 8 14 to 16 we read

For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God

The Spirit you received does not make you slaves,

so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, Father."

Romans 8 16

The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.

For the creation waits in eager expectation for the children of God to be revealed.

Romans 8 20 to 23 we read

For the creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own choice, but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope

that the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the freedom and glory of the children of God.

We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time.

Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption to sonship, the redemption of our bodies.
