SOWING SEED

Matthew 13 37 and 38 say

He answered, "The one who sowed the good seed is the Son of Man.

The field is the world, and the good seed stands for the people of the kingdom. The weeds are the people of the evil one,

Second Corinthians 9 10 says

Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food

will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness.

Genesis 26 12 says

Isaac planted crops in that land and the same year reaped a hundredfold, because the LORD blessed him.

Psalms 126 5 and 6 say

Those who sow with tears will reap with songs of joy.

Those who go out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying sheaves with them.

Psalms 97 11 says

Light shines on the righteous and joy on the upright in heart.

James 3 18 says

Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness.

Matthew 13 8 says

Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop, a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown.

Ecclesiastes 11 6 says

Sow your seed in the morning, and at evening let your hands not be idle,

for you do not know which will succeed, whether this or that, or whether both will do equally well.

First Corinthians 3 6 and 7 say

I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow.

So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow.

Hosea 10 12 says

Sow righteousness for yourselves, reap the fruit of unfailing love, and break up your unplowed ground;

for it is time to seek the LORD, until he comes and showers his righteousness on you.

Ecclesiastes 11 4 says

Whoever watches the wind will not plant; whoever looks at the clouds will not reap.

Second Corinthians 9 6 and 7 say

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

Galatians 6 7 to 9 we read

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.

Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction;

whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.

Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

John 12 24 and 25 say

Very truly I tell you, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed.

But if it dies, it produces many seeds.

Anyone who loves their life will lose it, while anyone who hates their life in this world will keep it for eternal life.

Luke 6 38 says

Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap.

For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

Proverbs 22 8 says

Whoever sows injustice reaps calamity, and the rod they wield in fury will be broken.

Job 4 8 says

As I have observed, those who plow evil and those who sow trouble reap it.

Proverbs 11 18 says

A wicked person earns deceptive wages, but the one who sows righteousness will reap a sure reward.
