TEMPLE

Psalms 122:1 says

I rejoiced with those who said to me, "Let us go to the house of the LORD."

First Kings 6:7 says

In building the temple, only blocks dressed at the quarry were used, and no hammer,

chisel or any other iron tool was heard at the temple site while it was being built.

Second Chronicles 7:1,2 and 3 say

When Solomon finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering,

and the sacrifices, and the glory of the LORD filled the temple.

The priests could not enter the temple of the LORD because the glory of the LORD filled it.

When all the Israelites saw the fire coming down and the glory of the LORD above the temple,

they knelt on the pavement with their faces to the ground, and they worshiped and gave thanks to the LORD, saying, "He is good; his love endures forever."

Psalms 5:7 says

But I, by your great love, can come into your house; in reverence I bow down toward your holy temple.

Psalms 27:4 says

One thing I ask from the LORD, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life,

to gaze on the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple.

Psalms 18:6 says

In my distress I called to the LORD; I cried to my God for help. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came before him, into his ears.

Psalms 84:10 says

Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere;

I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked.

Psalms 92:13 says
planted in the house of the LORD, they will flourish in the courts of our God.

Isaiah 6:1,2,3 and 4 say
In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple.

Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying.

And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory.

At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke.

Isaiah 56:7 says
these I will bring to my holy mountain and give them joy in my house of prayer.

Their burnt offerings and sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house will be called a house of prayer for all nations."

Haggai 2:9 says
'The glory of this present house will be greater than the glory of the former house,' says the LORD Almighty.

And in this place I will grant peace,' declares the LORD Almighty."

The Acts 5:42 says
Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Messiah.

The Acts 2:46 and 47 say
Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts,

praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

First Corinthians 6:19 and 20 say
Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own;

you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.

First Corinthians 3:17

If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person; for God's temple is sacred, and you together are that temple.

Second Corinthians 6:16

What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God.

As God has said: "I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people."

Yes ! Let us go to the house of the LORD with joy and in reverence, let us bow down toward His holy temple, and declare that God is good and His love endures for ever.
